Schedule Changes will begin before school starts on **Aug 1st (seniors), 2nd (juniors) and 3rd (sophomores) from 8 to 3 (counselors will take lunch from 12 to 1), and Aug 11th (9TH) during orientation.** If you are out of town or cannot make these days, do not worry, we will be doing necessary changes for a week after school begins.
