

GWHS Scholarship Newsletter #2 – October , 2018

1. ACT Prep Classes- Bridge Valley. They will offer two sessions. **September 25 – October 23, and November 1 – December 6.** Classes will meet each Tuesday and Thursday from 4:00 to 7:00 p.m. on their South Charleston Campus. The cost of the class is \$200.00 and covers the instruction and the ACT Official Test Prep Guide. Payment will be due ten days before the start of each class. 2. 2019-20 FAFSA Opens – Any student planning to attend college in the 2019-20 academic year should file a FAFSA at fafsa.gov beginning **October 1, 2018.**
3. Promise Scholarship – Applications open for the class of 2019 on **October 1, 2018.**
4. Going Merry – This is a free platform that enables students to find and apply directly to all of their scholarships from one site. It also allows counselors to track and support their students' applications. Go to www.goingmerry.com/sign-up.
5. Important Dates to Remember: September 29 – October 14 - Late fee required to register for the October 27 ACT.
6. March 2 Success- This is an online, self-paced course designed to improve student performance on standardized tests while enhancing student math, science, English and STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) skills. It is available 24 hours/day, 7/days per week so that students can log on at all times. This is through the US Army but there is no obligation whatsoever.
7. Brandeis University Scholarships – Numerous scholarships are available for outstanding students that range from \$10,000 to \$20,500 annually. These scholarships are awarded to the most academically outstanding students. Students do not need to apply for merit funding. They will be thoroughly considered during the application process. Please see your counselor for additional information.
8. Make the U Scholarship – 31 Awards - \$15,000. Applicants must show academic excellence and demonstrate dedication to community service. Applications can be found by going to: <https://studentscholarships.org/scholarship/12459/make-the-u-scholarship-scholarship.php>. **Deadline: October 15, 2018.**
9. Hispanic Heritage Youth Awards - \$3,500. 180 Awards. Applicant must be currently enrolled in high school and graduating in 2019, have a minimum unweighted 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale or 7.5 on a 10.0 scale and be of Hispanic heritage (includes Spain, Brazil and Philippines). 10. AmericanMuscle Student Scholarship Program - \$2,000 – 4 Awards. Applicants must be currently enrolled in an American college, technical institute, or high school senior planning to attend a college or post-secondary institution in 2019. 11. Cl Pony Parts Scholarship Video Contest - \$500. Applicant must be a US resident who will be enrolling in post-secondary education in their next semester. Applicant must create a short video, under three minutes long, on one of the following topics: What it means to live in America; My first memory of a Mustang; How the auto industry changed America; What a Mustang teaches me about life; How a Mustang relates to your field of study. Award is open to all fields of study and is not exclusive to automotive or related degrees. **Deadline: October 15, 2018.**
12. Branson Shows Inspired Scholarship - \$1,000. Applicant must be a legal resident of the US between the ages of 16 and 19. Essay on the following topic is required. How (enter your show) inspired me to realize my dreams. **Deadline: October 15, 2018.**
13. The Thomas Wolfe Scholarship at UNC/Chapel Hill – Student writers interested in UNC must submit applications for early admissions and the scholarship. Applications may be submitted beginning September 1, 2018. It is a two-step process. An application to the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill by **October 15, 2018** and an application to the Thomas Wolfe Scholarship by **November 15, 2018**. Students must apply to both to be considered. Final decision will be made in April, 2019. 14. Dr. Pepper Tuition Giveaway - \$100,000. 20 Awards. Applicant must be a legal resident of the 50 United States and be between the ages of 18-24. 15. Wendy's High School Heisman Scholarship - \$5,000. 100 Awards will be given. Applicants must have a cumulative high school grade point of 3.0, participate in at least one of the 47 sports recognized by the International Olympic Committee in the summer and winter Olympic Games. 16. LendEDU Scholarship – \$1,000. Applicant must be a US citizen who is a current high school senior or full-time college student with a minimum 2.5 GPA. A 750-word response to the following question, "With more people taking on student debt to pay for college and record high default rates, what do you think can be done to improve the financial literacy of our nation's young adults to help this problem?" is required. **Deadline: October 19, 2018.**
17. US Bank Scholarship Program - \$20,000. **Deadline: October 26, 2018.**
18. MyProjectorLamps Scholarship - \$500. **Deadline: October 31, 2018.**
19. \$1,000 CARIID Scholarship Program – **Deadline: October 31, 2018**
20. VIP Scholarship - \$5,000 – 1 Award. Applicant must be a US citizen and currently be enrolled in college or high school and be at least 13 years of age or older. 21. Halloween Express Scholarship Contest - \$1,000. Applicant must be a current undergraduate student at any two-year, four-year, or vocational/technical college/university. An essay about Halloween costumes is required. **Deadline: October 31, 2018.**
22. HP Scholarship - \$1,000 – 1 Award. Applicant must be a legal resident of the 50 United States and DC and be 13 years or older at time of entry. 23. SP Scholarships - \$10,000 – 10 Awards. Applicant must be at least 13 years old and enrolled or will enroll in a college or university in the US and be a legal resident of the US or Puerto Rico. 24. Coca-Cola Scholars Program - \$20,000 – 150 Awards. Applicant must be a current high school (or home-schooled student attending a school in the US (or select DoD schools) who will graduate during the 2018-19 academic school year. 25. University of Dayton Leadership in Service Scholarship – This is a scholarship for seniors with a passion for personal development and a commitment to service to receive a \$10,000 scholarship. **Counselor must nominate student. If you are interested, please see your counselor for details. Deadline: November 1, 2018.**
26. NCWIT Award for Aspirations in Computing - \$500 – 391 Awards. Applicant must be a female 13 years of age or older and be a US citizen or permanent resident who attends school in the US or is a US citizen attending school in Puerto Rico, Guam, the US Virgin Islands or on a US overseas military base. 27. North American Van Lines Logistics Scholarship - \$1,000 – 5 Awards. 31. Deadline to Submit the FAFSA – Deadline to complete the FAFSA and complete the application to apply for PROMISE Scholarship – **March 1, 2019.**
32. WV Higher Education Grant Program – Deadline to submit the FAFSA to apply for WV Higher Education Grant Program – **April 15, 2019.**
33. Nursing Scholarship – Application becomes available – **April 15, 2019.**
34. Federal Pell Grant – <http://www.fafsa.gov> - **June 1, 2019.**
35. Christian College Scholarship Drawing – Applicant must be a high school junior or senior who plans to enroll for the first time as a full-time student at a Christ-centered Christian college or Bible college with 18 months of being notified that they have won the award. **Deadline: May 31, 2019.**
36. Christian College Edge Scholarship - \$1,000. Applicant must complete a survey found on the sponsor's website to be automatically entered into scholarship drawing. Applicant must also be enrolling for the first time as a full-time student at a Christian college/university. **Deadline: May 31, 2019.**
37. University of Texas – Dallas McDermott Scholarship Program – These scholars are an eclectic and multi-talented group of individuals. It offers: \$1,400/monthly stipends year around, \$1,000/yearly textbook stipend, \$12,000 to study abroad, \$3,000 for professional development, tickets to cultural events in Dallas, travel home twice a year and much, much more. Value: \$250,000
38. H&R Block Budget Challenge – Learn fiscal discipline and budgeting skills.
