

GWHS Grading and Honors' Guidelines







Grade Classification:

- Promotion from Grade 9 to Grade 10 occurs when the student has earned 5 credits and passed 6 of 8 semesters in English, Social Studies, Mathematics, and Science.
- Promotion from Grade 10 to Grade 11 occurs when the student has earned 11 credits.
- Promotion from Grade 11 to Grade 12 occurs when the student has earned 17 credits.
- Graduation from GWHS occurs when 24 credits are met, and with the required courses.
- · Any Core or Required course with a Failing Grade (F), must be made up (recovered), in the following ways: Summer School (there is a fee), take the class over the following year, Graduate Support/Credit Recovery class (there is a fee).
- All grades, including "F's," will always remain on the final transcript. Once the failed class is recovered, that grade will appear on the transcript as well.

Commencement Recognition:

- 3.8 GPA = Honors
- 4.0 GPA = High Honors (with a minimum of 14 weighted credits by the end of 7 semesters/1SM of Senior year).
- 4.5 GPA = Highest Honors (with a minimum of 14 weighted credits by the end of 7 semesters/1SM of Senior year).
