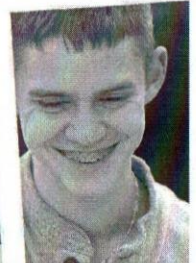
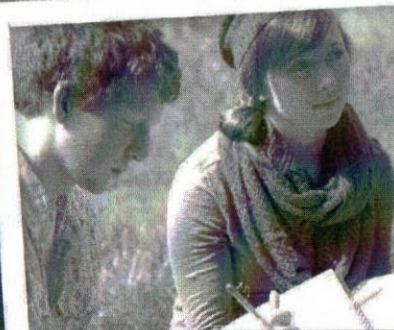
for EDUCATORS
